

**REQUEST FOR BIDS
PENINSULA METROPOLITAN PARK DISTRICT**

BID NOTICE

Peninsula Metropolitan Park District (PenMet Parks) will receive sealed bids for Project #2016-02 Sehmel-Homestead Park Synthetic Turf Fields, at the offices the Peninsula Metropolitan Parks District, Volunteer Vern Pavilion, 10123 78th Avenue NW, Gig Harbor, WA 98332 until September 22, 2016 at 12:00 pm PST. Bids will then be publicly read aloud at the same location at 1:00 pm PST. Bids received after the appointed time set for receipt will be returned unopened.

The project scope includes removing existing dirt infields and existing natural turf areas, installing synthetic turf over new permeable aggregate base, constructing new warning tracks, and associated work including, but not limited to adjusting existing irrigation system around new construction, erosion control, demolition, and sodding, all in accordance with the Contract Documents.

The Engineer's Probable Opinion of Cost ranges from \$500,000.00 to \$560,000.00.

A non-mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at the Project Site at 11:00 a.m. on September 8, 2016, PST

The Project does not have Federal Aid Funding.

Free-of-charge access to project bid documents (plans, specifications, addenda, and Bidders List) is provided to Prime Bidders, Subcontractors, and Vendors by going to www.bxwa.com and clicking on "Posted Projects", "Public Works", and "Peninsula Metropolitan Park District". This online plan room provides Bidders with fully usable online documents with the ability to: download, view, print, order full/partial plan sets from numerous reprographic sources, and a free online digitizer/take-off tool. It is recommended that Bidders "Register" in order to receive automatic e-mail notification of future addenda and to place themselves on the "Self-Registered Bidders List". Bidders that do not register will not be automatically notified of addenda and will need to periodically check the on-line plan room for addenda issued on this project. All bids must be submitted on the forms furnished for that purpose, and each proposal shall be accompanied by bid bond, or certified check made payable to the Peninsula Metropolitan Parks District, in the amount of not less than (5) percent of the total bid amount.
