- Prudently manage District funds by maximizing the use of tax revenues by using other resources such as ...volunteers; and


WHEREAS, the Board included the Park Enhancement Grant (PEG) Program in the Capital Improvement Program as part of the adopted 2010 Annual Budget; and

WHEREAS, the PEG Program Process and Procedures were approved by the Board in May, 2007; NOW, THEREFORE BE IT


RESOLVED by the Board of Park Commissioners of the Peninsula Metropolitan Park District (PenMet Parks) to award a 2010 PEG Grant to:

- EnviroCorps in the amount not to exceed \$1,000.


The foregoing resolution was adopted at a regular meeting of the Board of Park Commissioners of the Peninsula Metropolitan Park District held on May 17, 2010.
