RESOLUTION NO. R2009-010

A RESOLUTION OF PENMET PARKS AMENDING RESOLUTION R2007-002 REGARDING PUBLIC RECORDS DISCLOSURE RULES

WHEREAS, Chapter 42.56 RCW requires all government entities to adopt rules covering the disclosure of public records; and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Attorney General has drafted model rules to assist government agencies in preparing and adopting their own rules concerning the disclosure of public records; and


WHEREAS, the District Board of Park Commissioners on February 5, 2007 adopted Resolution 2007-002 establishing a District Public Disclosure Policy; and

WHEREAS, State law governs what agencies can charge for copies of documents; and


WHEREAS, the District now has the internal capability to make color copies, reducing the actual per page cost for photocopies, and no longer needs to charge rates higher than the State's maximum per page cost of \$0.15; NOW THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED by the Board of Park Commissioners of the Peninsula Metropolitan Park District (PenMet Parks) that the Public Records Disclosure Rules be amended as attached as Exhibit A and are approved and adopted.


The foregoing resolution was adopted at a regular meeting of the Board of Park Commissioners of the Peninsula Metropolitan Park District held on June 15, 2009.
