

**REQUEST FOR BIDS

BID NOTICE**

Peninsula Metropolitan Park District (PenMet Parks) will receive sealed bids for Project #2019.01 Sehmel Homestead Park Lighting Project, at the offices of the Peninsula Metropolitan Parks District, Volunteer Vern Pavilion, [5717 Wollochet Dr NW, Gig Harbor, WA 98335](#) until October 10, 2019 at 12:00 PM. Bids will then be publicly read aloud at the same location at 1:00 pm PST. Bids received after the appointed time set for receipt will be returned unopened.

The project scope includes: The construction of power to Musco furnished and installed soccer field lights/poles and power/control cabinet along with contractor construction of parking lot lights, concrete bases, conduit and wire by directional bore and trenching, all in accordance with the contract documents. The project is located at 10123 78th Avenue NW, Gig Harbor, WA. 98332

The Engineer's Probable Opinion of Cost is \$640,000.00.

A non-mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at the Project Site at 9:00 a.m. on October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019, PDT.

The Project does not have Federal Aid Funding.

Bidders that do not register will not be automatically notified of addenda and will need to periodically check the BXWA on-line plan room, DJC, or PenMet Parks for addenda issued on this project.

All bids must be submitted on the forms furnished for the purpose, and each proposal shall be accompanied by bid bond, or certified check made payable to the Peninsula Metropolitan Park District, in the amount of not less than (5) percent of the total bid amount.
